## Taking your Friends to Fenway Park

The Boston Red Sox baseball team plays its home games in Fenway Park.

Take a look at the seating chart of Fenway Park and the 2009 prices for seats in each section.

The seating chart is a MAP of Fenway Park. The price chart is the MAP KEY.

## Can you solve these problems using the FENWAY MAP and the MAP KEY?

I. What seating sections are behind home plate?
2. What seating sections are closest to first base? Second base? Third base?
3. What sections do you think are the best seats? Why?
4. You are bringing 3 friends to the game. Where would you like to sit? Pick a section. How much will it cost for the four of you?
5. Pick a different section of the park. How much will it cost for the four of you in the new section?
6. What is the least expensive section for you to sit in?
7. You have $\$ 100$ to spend for your ticket and food at the Red Sox game. Choose a section to sit in. How much is the ticket? How much do you have leftover to buy food?
8. How much would it cost for you and a friend to buy seats in the bleachers? (Sections 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 49, 4I, 42, and 43)

## Challenge questions!

I. Maria, Shawna, Peter and Samir are going to the game. Each person is sitting in a different section, so they have a different view of the game. What sections will they choose? How much will it cost the group to go to the game?
