

5. Pick a different section of the park. How much will it cost for the four of you in the new section?
6. What is the least expensive section for you to sit in?
7. You have \$100 to spend for your ticket and food at the Red Sox game. Choose a section to sit in. How much is the ticket? How much do you have leftover to buy food?
8. How much would it cost for you and a friend to buy seats in the bleachers? (Sections 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 49, 41, 42, and 43)
